GECAMIN LTDA. PRIVACY AND PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION POLICY

Latest update, March, 2023

This document informs you about the data use policy of the company Gecamin Ltda., in compliance with the personal data protection regulations by Law No. 19.628, of 1999, on the Protection of Privacy; the provisions of Article 19 No. 4 of the Constitution of the Republic of Chile and Law No. 20.575, which establishes the Principle of Purpose in the Processing of Personal Data. This policy also complies with the principles enshrined in Article 5 and Recital 39 of the European Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

Gecamin is a company that organizes conferences, congresses and technical seminars for the mining industry. For the purposes of this "Privacy and Protection Policy", "participant" or "registered" means a person who registers for our conferences voluntarily, either independently or on behalf of his or her company. Meanwhile, "user" is understood as a person who freely accesses the information available at www.gecamin.com and the sites derived from each conference, without the need for prior registration.

DATA COLLECTION AND STORAGE

Conference participants register in the forms specially established for this purpose, where they are requested to include: full name, ID number, position, as well as e-mail and telephone number; in addition to the billing information of the company or natural person, depending on the case. At the end of the registration, they are asked to authorize or not to share their personal data with the sponsors for commercial and advertising purposes.

This information is stored in SIBADA, the CRM used internally to manage the data collected. It is worth mentioning that the data is kept within the national territory, with the exception of the catastrophic backups that remain on the East Coast of the United States.

SIBADA also receives contacts of professionals provided by third parties and those found in the search and acquisition of potential clients from publicly available sources. This data, as well as the data extracted from the forms of registered participants, is constantly reviewed and updated, making sure to delete or deactivate those data that are outdated or out of date for the advertising and commercial purposes for which they are collected.

USE AND PROCESSING OF REGISTERED PARTICIPANT DATA

The information collected from participants and their companies allows us to generate internal statistics and analysis in order to generate outreach, advertising and commercial activities. These include the use of paid digital search and remarketing campaigns, some of them directed to new users who visit our websites and to segmented groups of previously registered participants, through customer lists shared to Google Ads in CSV format. Likewise, we make use of the participants' information for further contact via individualized email, phone call and instant message using WhatsApp Business.

In addition to the above, lists of registered participants are automatically subscribed to regular email newsletters (mailings). This subscription can be unsubscribed by logging in here.

Finally, the personal data (name, position, company) and contact information (e-mail and telephone) of the participants registered in the respective conferences are shared with third parties categorized as sponsors, who are companies that pay a fee for having brand presence and access to special benefits such as obtaining the aforementioned data to be used for commercial and/or technical purposes.

USE OF COOKIES.

A cookie is a file that is downloaded to a computer when accessing certain web pages. Cookies allow a web page, among other things, to store and retrieve information about the browsing habits of a user or his or her computer and, depending on the information they contain and the way you use your computer, they can be used to recognize the user.

Gecamin uses cookies on its Web sites to obtain data to 1) improve the quality of the Web sites and 2) conduct digital campaigns for advertising purposes.

What types of cookies do we use?

Performance cookies:

They allow us to quantify the number of users and thus perform the measurement and statistical analysis of the use made by users of the service offered. To do this, your browser on our website is analyzed in order to improve the service we offer.
